IMPORTANT KEYS

1. This is the most critical election of our lifetime.
2. Recheck and make sure you are registered to vote.
3. Make sure your family and friends from 18 years and above are registered to vote.
4. Be sure to vote by mail, in person or by early voting (if available)

COVID-19 UPDATE

On **May 8, 2020**, Governor Gavin Newsom issued **Executive Order N-64-20**, which, among other things, orders that a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed to each **REGISTERED** voter prior to the **November 3, 2020** election in addition to offering in-person voting locations.
